The GDPR will become enforceable on May 25, 2018 and companies which are not compliant with the GDPR may face significant penalties and enforcement. Provisions regarding compliance with the GDPR often are included in a Security Addendum or a related agreement.

- Key definitions in U.S. federal and state laws and the GDPR.
- When the GDPR and its requirements apply to a company.
- What companies are requiring from their vendors and practical approaches for companies and vendors.
- Penalties and enforcement.
