This Act becomes operative July 1, 2024, subject to specified exceptions. This Act furthers the purposes and intent of the California Privacy Rights Act ("CPRA") and applies to a business subject to the CPRA. More specifically, this Act applies to a business (as defined in Cal Civ. Code § 1798.140) that provides an online service, product or feature likely to be accessed by children, meaning California residents who are under 18 years of age.
